 - Poster may be created with various art supplies: paints, colored pencils, and charcoal, but we also allow collage materials to be used (if using paints or glues they must be completely dry when poster is submitted)
 - Poster must relate to this year's theme, Take a Stand
 - No profanity, nudity, or otherwise offensive items/words/images may be used
 - Judges will examine the exploration and use of this year's theme, as well as creativity, when making their decisions
